



World Wide Knit in Public Day Bracelet

MATERIALS

6 grams 5/2 perle mercerized cotton yarn

- US Size 1 [2.25mm] needles
- 36 size 8 Miyuki seed beads
- Dental floss threader for stringing on beads

SIZES

This pattern is one size fits all

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

1.5 inches by 12 inches



NOTES

Knitting with beads (k1b)-

Insert the right ndl into the loop on the left ndl to work a stitch as usual, then slide 1 bead up until it is almost but not quite touching the right ndl. Wrap the yarn around the right ndl, ready to make the new stitch. The bead should be sitting “on top” of the right ndl. Then work the stitch, pulling the bead through. The bead(s) will lock into place on the new stitch you just made.

ICORD -

Knit all sts, then without turning work slide sts to the other end of the needle. Repeat this step until you have completed the number of rows stated in the pattern.

ABBREVIATIONS

- bo - bind off
- k - knit
- k1b - knit 1 with a bead [see notes]
- k2tog - knit 2 together [1 st decreased]
- m1L - (make one left) - with left ndl tip lift strand between ndls from front to back, k lifted loop through the back [1 st inc]
- m1R - (make one right) - with left ndl tip lift strand between ndls from back to front, k lifted loop through the front [1 st inc]
- ndl(s) - needle(s)
- p - purl
- sl- slip, pattern will instruct if the stitch is to be slipped knit or purlwise
- ssk - (slip, slip, knit) - slip next 2 sts, one by one, as if to knit; insert tip of lh ndl from left to right into the fronts of these two slipped sts and knit them together [1 st decreased]
- wyif- with yarn in front

SETUP

With dental floss threader, string on 36 beads.

With Cast on of your choice, cast on 5 sts.

Work ICord for 16 rows (see notes on how to work icord)

INCREASING

Row 1 (RS): K3, wyif SI 2 sts

Row 2 (WS): K3, wyif SI 2 sts

Row 3: K2, M1R, K1, M1L, wyif SI 2 sts [7 sts]

Row 4: P5, wyif SI 2 sts

Row 5: K5, wyif SI 2 sts

Row 6: P5, wyif SI 2 sts

Repeat rows 5 & 6 once more

Row 9: K2, M1R, K3, M1L, wyif SI 2 sts [9 sts]

Row 10: P7, wyif SI 2 sts

Row 11: K7, wyif SI 2 sts

Row 12: P7, wyif SI 2 sts

Row 13: K2, M1R, K5, M1L, wyif SI 2 sts [11 sts]

Row 14: P9, wyif SI 2 sts

BEAD SECTION

Row 15: K2, K1b, K1, K1b,K1, K1b, K1, K1b, wyif Sl 2 sts [11 sts]

Row 16: (and all even WS rows): P to last 2 sts, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 17: K3, K1b, K1, K1b, K1, K1b, K1, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 19: K4, K1b, K1, K1b, K2, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 21: K5, K1b, K3, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 23: K to last 2 sts, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 25: K5, K1b, K3, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 27: K4, K1b, K1, K1b, K2, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 29: K3, K1b, K1, K1b, K1, K1b, K1, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 31: K2, K1b, K1, K1b,K1, K1b, K1, K1b, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 33: K3, K1b, K1, K1b, K1, K1b, K1, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 35: K4, K1b, K1, K1b, K2, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 37: K5, K1b, K3, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 39: K to last 2 sts, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 41: K5, K1b, K3, wyif Sl 2 sts K2,

Row 43: K4, K1b, K1, K1b, K2, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 45: K3, K1b, K1, K1b, K1, K1b, K1, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 47: K2, K1b, K1, K1b,K1, K1b, K1, K1b, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 48: P to last 2 sts, wyif Sl 2 sts

DECREASE SECTION

Row 49: K to last 2 sts, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 50: P to last 2 sts, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 51: K2, ssk, K3, K2tog, wyif Sl 2 sts [9 sts]

Row 52: P to last 2 sts, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 53: K7, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 54: P7, wyif Sl 2 sts

REPEAT ROWS 53 & 54 ONCE MORE

Row 55: K2, ssk, K1, K2tog, wyif Sl 2 sts [7 sts]

Row 56: P to last 2 sts, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 57: K5, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 58: P5, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 59: K2, ssk, K2tog, wyif Sl 1 sts [5 sts]

Row 60: P to last sts, wyif Sl1 st

Row 61: K3, wyif Sl 2 sts

Row 62: K3, wyif Sl 2 sts

FINISHING UP:

Work icord for 16 rows

BO sts knit wise

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
